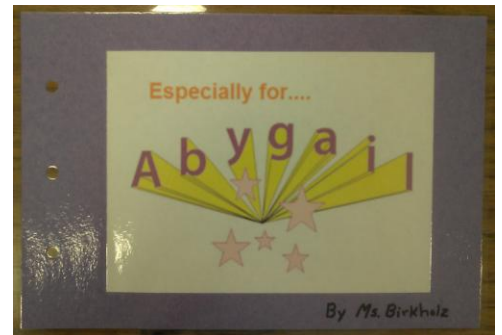
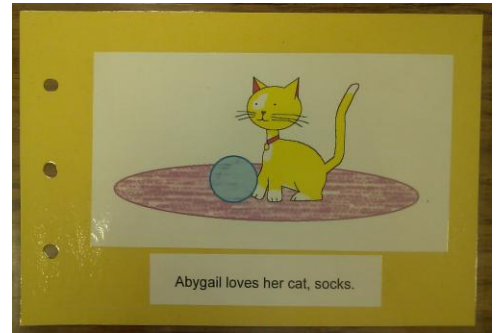
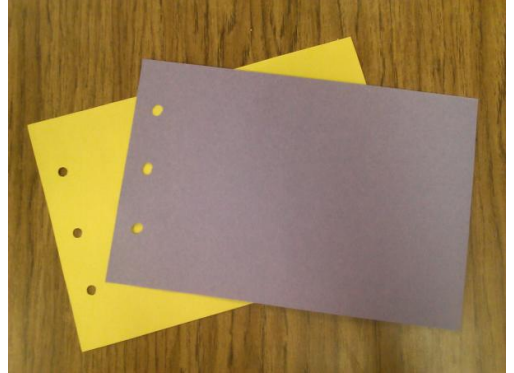


Make the Book Part 2 – Lamination Prep

After your color copies look top-quality, prepare them for lamination.

- 1) Choose colors of construction paper that complement the illustrations (9x12 sheets). You may choose one color for all the pages, or choose different colors for each page.
- 2) Cut the 9x12 sheets of paper into six 6x9 halves. Make sure the edges are straight and tidy. The half-sheets will become the pages.
- 3) Use a hole punch to make 3 to 5 holes evenly along the left edge of each page – Make sure each page's holes line up with each other.
- 4) Carefully glue an illustration and its matching narration on the "front" of each page -- Make sure the holes are on the left. Make sure the illustrations and text are glued on evenly and cleanly. The finished pages should look clean and pleasantly balanced. See the example pictured here.
- 5) Remember to glue the front cover and end page too, in a balanced and pleasant way.
- 6) Write your name legibly in the bottom right corner of the cover page. See the example pictured here.
- 7) When all of your gluing is dry, stack your pages in a pile and turn them in.
